# 10. Good of Lionism:

A) Inn from the Cold Reception: Lion Rick Metcalfe

-the new Catch the Ace lottery was to be for Club initiatives, it is suggested some of the profits be earmarked for Inn from the Cold, no specific amount

-other projects that could benefit from Catch the Ace profits include the accessible playground -accessible playground is probably years in the future, whereas Inn from the Cold has an immediate need
